Manpower needed for survey works are included in Manpower cost item in BoQ and other associated cost for survey works (datacollection, equipment hiring) are included in Field work item of BoQ.
2	Hydrological and Sediment Data It has been mentioned in Tor that no gauge installation has been done previously and also not include in this feasibility study scope as well. Shall hydrological and sediment data fully rely on exiting Chameliya Project? Or any discharge measurement is needed?? Please clarify this issue. 3	Project lay-out Map The project lay-out map given with RFP document is not clear. Please provide the clear map.	Project stretch is tailrace of Chamelia project to confluence of Naugad and the overall boundary for the project is as marked in RFP document

2	Is any Drill Holes at middle of the river or not?	There is no drill holes in the river specified in this stage.
