INVITATION TO PROPOSAL

NATIONAL COMPETITIVE BIDDING

Development of Lower Indrawati 4.5 MW Hydropower Project

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The Department of Electricity Development, (DOED), of the Ministry of Energy, Water Resources and Irrigation of Government of Nepal intends to develop Lower Indrawati 4.5 MW Hydropower Project under Build, Own, Operate and Transfer (BOOT) arrangements by licensing the projects to Firm/ Company selected through National Competitive Bidding (NCB) as per the provision of Directives for Licencing of Power Project, 2075. The Project is now being offered for exclusive bidding to the bidders for development, engineering, financing, construction, operation and transfer to the Government.

- 1. DOED invites Bids from Firm/Company to develop, finance, build, own, operate the Lower Indrawati 4.5 MW Hydropower Project for a fixed term.
- Bidding for project is open to all registered Firm/Company. Firm/Company should produce copies of their Company Registration Certificate and Tax Clearance Certificate for FY 2075-76 or it's extension to purchase RFP document.
- 3. The RFP document may be obtained from the Procurement Unit, DOED, Sanogaucharan, Kathmandu. on submission of a request letter accompanied by a bank voucher of a non-refundable NRs 20,000 (Nepalese Rupee Twenty Thousand only), deposited in GON Revenue Account No. 1000200010000 in name of Office Code 308013501 (Department of Electricity Development) Revenue Title No. 14229 (Prashasanik Sulka) in Rastriya Banijya Bank.
- 4. Bidders are advised to arrange collection of RFP documents through their own designated representatives and/or courier, and ensure themselves receipt of complete RFP documents. DOED shall not assume any responsibility for dispatching the RFP documents and/or for missing of any documents during the transmittal.
- 5. Bidders are expected to examine all instructions, forms, terms, specifications and other information in the RFP documents. Failure to furnish all information required by the RFP documents or submission of a Bid not substantially responsive to the RFP documents in every respect shall be at the Bidder's risk and may result in rejection of the submitted Bid.
- 6. All Bids must be received to DOED on or before *March 10, 2020, 12:00 Hrs* Nepal Standard Time. Bids received after the Deadline shall be rejected and returned to the Bidder(s) unopened. The Technical Bid Opening shall take place on *March 10, 2020,* 14:00 hrs, Nepal Standard Time at Meeting Hall of DOED.
